	Contents	Recently, Alternative Methods are getting widely utilized. Although these methods are valid for the evaluation of the effects and adverse effects, they alone is not sufficient to evaluate risk. To evaluate the risk of interdermal preparations, the adverse effects may be estimated by Alternative Methods, and, before clinical study, the evaluation combining in vitro dermal absorption and total body clearance may be performed. This will be the future evaluation style in this field.
